- For stories from *The Facts On File World News Digest, Issues and Controversies On File, Today's Science On File,* and *Editorials On File,* each citation should include:

Format,

"The Title of the Article." The Print Publication, with the issue date. FACTS.com. Physical location from which the site was accessed including city, state. Date site was accessed. <<http://www.2facts.com>>

For Example,

"Safe Drinking Water Act Signed." Facts On File World News Digest, 22 August 1996. FACTS.com. CNN Library, Atlanta, GA. January 15, 2000. <<http://www.2facts.com/>>

"Issues and Controversies: Racial Disparities." Issues and Controversies On File, 13 January 1996. FACTS.com. Uris Library, Ithaca, NY. January 11, 2000. <<http://www.2facts.com/>>

"Asteroid's Path Explains Extinction Mysteries." Today's Science On File, January, 1997. FACTS.com. Birmingham Public Library, Birmingham, AL. January 10, 2000. <<http://www.2facts.com/>>

- For country profiles, "Key People" biographies, and "Key Event" and "Key Issue" background articles, each citation should include:

Format,

"The Title of the Article." FACTS.com. Physical location from which the site was accessed including city, state. Date site was accessed. <<http://www.2facts.com/>>

For Example,

Key Event: Egyptian President Sadat Slain." FACTS.com. Abington Junior High School, Abington, PA. January 3, 2000. <<http://www.2facts.com/>>
