STUDENT REPRESENTATIVES</p> <p>Section 1. <u>Purpose</u></p> <p>The Board recognizes that the students attending The School District of the City of Allentown are the most important concern of the district.</p> <p>The Board establishes the positions of student representatives to the Board to establish a communications link between itself and the student body and to receive the students' viewpoints and concerns.</p> <p>The Board directs that two (2) high school students, one from each high school, shall be selected to serve one-year, renewable terms as student representatives to The School District of the City of Allentown Board of School Directors with voice but not vote.</p> <p>Section 2. <u>Selection</u></p> <p>The Board shall appoint two (2) student representatives, one from each high school, who will serve at the discretion of the Board. (See administrative regulations)</p> <p>To be eligible, students must be at least sophomores at the time of their selection, must have a 2.0 or better average, and must maintain a 2.0 or better average, failing no courses, while serving a student representative.</p> <p>Section 3. <u>Term of Office</u></p> <p>The term of office of the student representatives shall begin with the September Board meeting.</p>

	<p>Section 4. <u>Responsibilities</u></p> <p>The two (2) student representatives may participate in all discussions and meetings of the Board and its committees, except those dealing with litigation, personnel or negotiations, and shall not attend closed or executive sessions.</p> <p>The student representatives shall have the right to place items on the agenda of the Board or its committees, to initiate topics for discussion during the course of a meeting, and to participate in Board debates, in accordance with established procedures of the Board.</p> <p>All correspondence to the Board members may be sent to the student representatives, at the discretion of the Board President and Superintendent.</p>
