EDUCATIONAL GOALS</p> <p>The Board recognizes that education is a vital function of the State and community. The community should be encouraged to participate in the establishment of the educational goals established for this school district.</p> <p>The Board shall establish educational goals for the district. Such goals will consider suggestions by representatives of the community, students, district personnel, and members of the Board.</p> <p>As a base for its educational program, the Board adopts the following goals, which will be used as the basis for the development of student academic standards to be attained by students as a requirement for graduation from high school.</p> <p>The district will:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Foster success for each student by offering a challenging, standards-based academic curriculum.2. Prepare students to be productive citizens and workers.3. Implement the technology plan and provide access to information technology throughout the district.4. Promote recognition, appreciation, and respect for each individual's uniqueness.5. Ensure a climate for learning through a safe and supportive environment for students and staff. <p>To achieve these goals, the district will:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Use financial and human resources efficiently and effectively.2. Develop and enhance partnerships with families, businesses, colleges and universities, health and community organizations, and governmental agencies.3. Assess and report our progress to the community on an annual basis.
