CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION</p> <p>The Board shall provide a program of career and technical education in order to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A. Prepare students for gainful employment as skilled workers or technicians in recognized and new or emerging occupations;</li> <li>B. Prepare students for enrollment in post-secondary education programs;</li> <li>C. Assist students in choosing meaningful career pathways.</li> </ul> <p>For purposes of this policy, <b>career and technical education</b> shall be defined as a series of planned academic and career and technical education courses articulated with one another to teach the knowledge and skills necessary to prepare students to effectively pursue recognized career employment.</p> <p>The Board shall support a program of career and technical education which will include student attendance at the Lehigh Career &amp; Technical Institute (LCTI) and participation in a cooperative program of career development.</p> <p>In order to maintain a program of career and technical education, the school district, in cooperation with and through LCTI, shall,</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A. Place students in work and career preparatory programs and supervise the nature and conduct of their employment.</li> <li>B. Establish the number of credits to be awarded toward graduation for career and technical education courses of study.</li> </ul> |
