202. ELIGIBILITY OF NONRESIDENT STUDENTS	
1. Purpose SC 1302	The Board reserves the right to verify the residency of any student and to require a sworn statement of residential support for a student who resides with a person other than her/his parent, guardian or custodian.
2. Authority SC 1305	<p>A. <u>Nonresident Children Placed In The District</u></p> <p>Any child placed in the home of a resident of this district by a court or an agency of government shall be admitted to the schools and shall receive the same benefits and be subject to the same duties as resident children.</p>
 SC 1306, 1309	<p>B. <u>Inmates Of Institutions</u></p> <p>A child who is an inmate of an institution for the care or training of children located within this district, is not a legal resident of the district by such placement, but shall be admitted to the schools of this district and a charge shall be made for tuition in accordance with statute.</p>
 SC 1302	<p>C. <u>Former Residents</u></p> <p>Regularly enrolled children whose parents move from the district at any time during the school year may not remain enrolled in the district except with payment of tuition.</p> <p>D. <u>Nonresident Students</u></p> <p>A nonresident student who qualifies under Section 1302 of the School Code shall be admitted to this district without payment of tuition, where attendance is justified on the grounds that the student lives full-time and not just for the school year with district residents who have assumed legal guardianship of the student. An exchange student visiting this country, who lives in the district, may be admitted without payment of tuition.</p>
