808. FOOD SERVICES	
1. Purpose	Food service programs of the district shall meet the needs of pupils in accordance with these guidelines.
2. Authority SC 504, 1337	<p>The Board shall provide food service in all schools of this district. The Director of Food Services may designate schools for participation in the breakfast program.</p> <p>Cafeterias, feeding stations, or lunchrooms shall serve only persons who are students, employees, or persons directly associated with school operations.</p>
3. Delegation of Responsibility	The Director of Food Services shall be responsible for the operation and supervision of the food services program.
SC 504, 1337	The cafeterias shall operate on a nonprofit basis. The Superintendent and/or her/his designee shall review the cafeteria accounts monthly and the auditor shall review these accounts annually.
SC 504	<p>Surplus funds accruing from the operation of the food services programs shall be used only for the improvement and maintenance of the food service program.</p> <p>The district shall participate in the Federal School Breakfast Program and Lunch Program.</p>
SC 1335	The Board shall make provision for free and reduced rate meals as prescribed by federal and state law, in accordance with these guidelines.
SC 504, 1337	The Director of Food Services shall prepare guidelines for the implementation of a food service program including the maintenance of facilities; the purchase of perishable foodstuffs, seasonal commodities and other supplies; accounting and depositing procedures for cafeteria funds; and control, safekeeping and storage of food and food equipment.
