RELATIONS WITH EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS</p> <p>It is the policy of the Board that strong lines of communication be maintained by the district with other districts and institutions which provide programs, training, or services not otherwise available to children residing in this district, and with districts whose resident students are enrolled in programs of this district.</p> <p>The district in which pupils are in attendance has responsibility and authority for said pupils. In order that those pupils receive maximum benefit from their program of studies, articulation between the cooperating institutions is essential.</p> <p>In order to maintain cordial and constructive relationships with other educational institutions, the Superintendent shall:</p> <p>A. <u>In the Case of Students it Receives from Another District</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Provide an orientation program for incoming pupils of sending districts.</li> <li>2. Provide an educational program appropriate for the needs of the student(s) received.</li> <li>3. Provide an adequate pupil progress report for sending districts to permit said districts to evaluate the educational preparation of their pupils.</li> <li>4. Inform the sending district of any serious discipline problems encountered with pupils from its district.</li> </ol> <p>B. <u>In the Case of Students Placed in Another District While Maintaining Enrollment in this District</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Develop procedures to follow the progress of the district's pupils during their career in the receiving school(s).</li> <li>2. Keep the Board informed of any problems of an individual or group nature that may adversely affect the educational progress of the district's pupils.</li> </ol>
