Technology Cleaning Instructions

The guidance below is provided by Dell Technologies, and can be found at https://www.dell.com/support/article/en-us/sln308919/guidance-for-keeping-your-dell-technologies-equipment-clean?lang=en

We understand customers may have questions about cleaning and disinfecting options for their Dell products. The guidance below applies to all Dell-branded PCs, monitors or display screen, docking stations, keyboards, and mice.

- 1. We recommended you wear disposable gloves when cleaning and disinfecting surfaces.
- 2. Turn off the device you plan to clean and disconnect AC power. Also remove batteries from items like wireless keyboards. Never clean a product while it is powered on or plugged in.
- 3. Disconnect any external devices.
- 4. Never spray any liquids directly onto the product.
- 5. Moisten a microfiber cloth with a mixture of 70% isopropyl alcohol / 30% water. The cloth should be damp, but not dripping wet. Excess moisture should be removed if the cloth is wet before wiping the product. Using any material other than a microfiber cloth could cause damage to your product.
- 6. Gently wipe the moistened cloth on the surfaces to be cleaned. Do not allow any moisture to drip into areas like keyboards, display panels, etc. Moisture entering the inside of an electronic product can cause damage to the product. Excessive wiping potentially could lead to damaging some surfaces.
- 7. When cleaning a display screen, carefully wipe in one direction, moving from the top of the display to the bottom.
- 8. Surfaces must be completely air-dried before turning the device on after cleaning. No moisture should be visible on the surfaces of the product before it is powered on or plugged in.
- 9. After cleaning or disinfecting a glass surface, it may be cleaned again using a glass cleaner designed for display surfaces following directions for that specific cleaner. We recommend you avoid glass cleaning products containing Ammonia.
- 10. Discard the disposable gloves used after each cleaning. Clean your hands immediately after gloves are removed and disposed.

Other cleaning chemicals are very harsh and will damage surfaces. Avoid using any of the following chemicals or products containing these chemicals:

Any chlorine-based cleaner, such as bleach



- Peroxides (including hydrogen peroxide)
- Solvents such as; acetone, paint thinner, benzene, methylene chloride or toluene
- Ammonia (i.e. Windex)
- Ethyl alcohol

Using any of the chemicals listed above will cause permanent damage to some product surfaces. By following the steps outlined in this document, you can minimize the risk of damage.

All the guidance above is provided by Dell Technologies, but is applicable to all brands. Please be careful to **read all labels** on any cleaning product before using on any technological devices.

DO NOT USE any of the harsh chemicals listed above to clean any computers or related devices.

NOTE: Ethyl Alcohol is generally contained in hand sanitizers. Therefore, hand sanitizers are not to be used on any computers or related devices

A- ASD assigned Chromebooks will only work with a district Google account.

Q- How should I sign into Clever?

A- You should use the same sign-in process you would at your school site.

Q- What should I do when signing into Google Classroom through Clever for the first time?

A- Clever **does** support Google Classroom integration, but only for SSO Saved Passwords. This means that students must type in their login again into Clever when attempting to connect to Google Classroom the first time.



FCC Initiative- Keep Americans Connected

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the FCC encouraged broadband, telephone connectivity providers, and trade associations to take the Keep Americans Connected Pledge. Companies that take the pledge agree to the following for the next 60 days:

- 1. Not terminate service to any residential or small business customers because of their inability to pay their bills due to the disruptions caused by the Coronavirus pandemic;
- 2. Waive any late fees that any residential or small business customers incur because of their economic circumstances re;ateds to the Coronavirus pandemic; and
- 3. Open its WiFi hotspots to any American who needs them.

T-Mobile and Metro by T-Mobile

- T-mobile took the Keep Americans Connected Pledge
- <u>T-Mobile Connect</u> is offering a \$15 per month plan for unlimited talk and text plus 2GB of high-speed smartphone data.
- New and current Metro customers with any voice line can also get a free 8" tablet (via rebate redemption) with a \$15 unlimited tablet data plan. (Plus sales tax and activation fee. Requires new line of tablet service. Not valid in CT/RI/Miami-Dade
- MetroSmart Hotspot devices will be half off, and the \$35 per month data plan will include 20GB double the normal monthly data for the next 60 days.
- T-Mobile is giving all current T-Mobile and Metro by T-Mobile customers as of March 13, 2020 who have legacy plans without unlimited high-speed data, unlimited smartphone data for the next 60 days (excluding roaming).
- Starting March 20, 2020, T-Mobile is providing eligible T-Mobile and Metro by T-Mobile customers on smartphone plans with hotspot data an additional 20GB of smartphone mobile hotspot (10GB per bill cycle for the next 60 days) for each voice line.
- T-Mobile is working with their Lifeline partners to provide customers extra free data up to 5GB of data per month through May 13, 2020.
