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Rules:

- 1. Essays, poetry and prose may be submitted as a writing piece. The submission must not exceed two pages in length and a title should appear at the top of the first page. Also, there should be no indication of the student's name in the writing piece.
- 2. Only one original student entry will be accepted. It should reflect his or her own thoughts and style of writing. Quotations from books or interviews may be used *sparingly*, but exact sources for quotes <u>must</u> be documented. No prize will be awarded if plagiarism is discovered.
- 3. Although it must be the student's original work, <u>teachers should make sure the spelling is correct and there are no obvious errors in facts.</u>
- 4. If there is documentation, it may be placed on the same page as the citation or on a third page reserved for that purpose only.
- 5. Entries will be judged based on thoughtfulness and originality of content, organization, clarity, and correctness of expression.
- 6. <u>There must be a cover sheet submitted with the essay</u> (fillable pdf provided or .docx). Please be sure that the following information is included on the cover sheet and does not appear elsewhere within the essay:
 - Student's name
 - Student's age
 - Student's home address
 - Student's school
 - Student's grade level

Note: Submissions with missing information from the cover sheet will be returned.

- 7. Please use the "teacher name" entry as acknowledgement that the student's work has been reviewed and that in his/her best judgment, the submission is the original work of the student.
- 8. Submissions and a list of <u>all</u> participants should be sent to curriculum@allentownsd.org, on or before March 6, 2024 by 12:00 p.m. Please be sure students follow all rules on this page or their submissions may be returned and will not be considered for a prize.
